Significant changes to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure went into effect on December 1, 2015. Knowledge of these changes will be essential to the handling of cases going forward that are filed in federal court, especially as it pertains to discovery (which is often times the longest and most costly portion of a lawsuit). Some of the noteworthy amendments are shorter time requirements, changes to the scope of discovery, and more stringent demands on parties responding to discovery.
